Volunteer Stipend Policy Addison County Communications Union District d/b/a/"Maple Broadband"

Adopted by Maple Broadband Executive Committee 05/02/2024

In recognition of a volunteer's exemplary contributions to the success of Maple Broadband, the volunteer may be awarded a stipend. The Executive Committee in its sole discretion determines applicable cases, and the magnitude and frequency of the stipend.

- 1) The stipend may not be more than 20% of the current market rate for the services provided.
- 2) The volunteer receiving the stipend is subject to any/all tax liabilities that result from receiving the stipend.
- 3) The stipend must be accommodated in the annual budget.

The stipend shall be discontinued either:

- 1) after the volunteer discontinues their engagement with Maple broadband; or,
- 2) in the sole judgment of the Executive Committee, the volunteer's contributions no longer justify the stipend, in which case the final decision on discontinuation requires Executive Committee approval.

The Executive Committee will inform the Governing Board of any new volunteer stipends awarded, altered or discontinued.
